Coffee tables in different sizes and heights available for indoor and outdoor use.

Indoor version: coffee tables with base made of shaped solid ash wood Ø40 mm, available in natural or charcoal-dyed finishes.

Tabletop available in 20 mm thick marble (with beveled edge) and natural matte protective coating, or glossy/matte polyester finish, or in 12 mm thick (straight cut) porcelain stoneware in colors and finishes in collection, fixed to the top using screws. Floor support provided by plastic supports and interchangeable feet (in black plastic material or felt) depending on the type of surface.

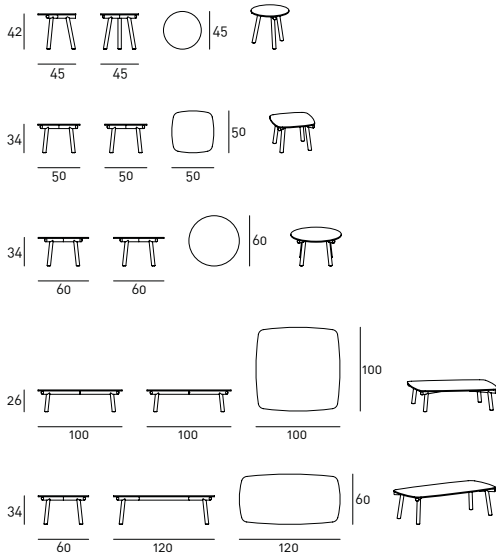
Outdoor version: coffee tables with base made of shaped solid Teak wood Ø40 mm. Table top available in 12 mm thick (straight cut) porcelain stoneware in colors and finishes in collection, fixed to the top using stainless steel screws.

Floor support provided by plastic supports and plastic black tips.

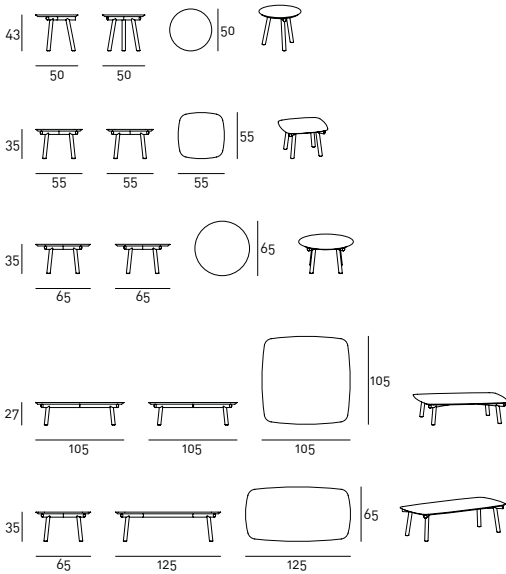

Porcelain stoneware top (Indoor-Outdoor)



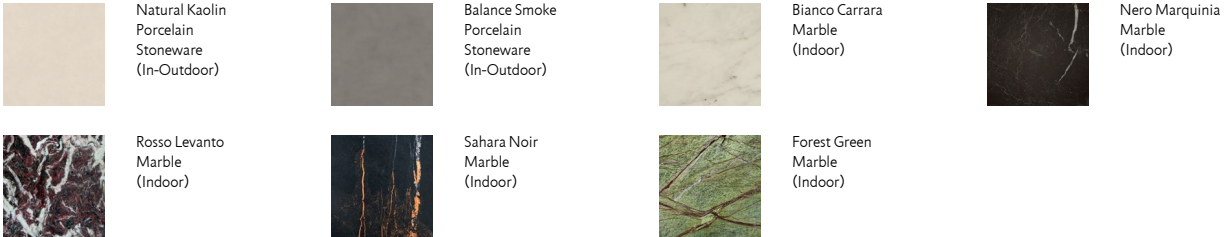
Marble top (Indoor)

Notes

Wood is a living material; therefore, it can have slight color and dimension changes. The presence of any non-homogeneous color shades is not to be considered a defect but a quality.

The solid Teak comes from certified plantations. It is an extremely resistant material, thanks to the presence of an oleo-resinous component that guarantees excellent durability. We also remind that Teak is a living material that reacts to external factors. Prolonged and continuous exposure to them changes the surface layer, up to oxidation which gives it a silvery-grey tone. Moreover, it can show small alterations in color and size. Teak may therefore present not homogeneous shades of color, to be considered as a quality and not a defect. For the maintenance of Teak kindly follow the instructions included in the maintenance kit supplied with the product.

Porcelain stoneware is an extremely dense ceramic material obtained by mixing various natural raw materials, such as clay and sand, and fired at high temperatures to make it waterproof and non-porous. The resulting surfaces have an absorption rate of less than 0.5%.

Porcelain stoneware is known for its durability, characterized by a surface hardness that makes it resistant to wear, scratches, and most physical and mechanical stresses. In addition, it is a safe material, resistant to high temperatures and thermal shocks, and NSF certified for direct food contact. Porcelain stoneware slabs do not contain volatile organic compounds (VOCs), which can be potentially toxic to humans and the environment, nor do they contain formaldehyde. They are also free from PVC, plastics, or petroleum derivatives.

For the OUTDOOR version, it is recommended to use a "Protective Cover" to improve the longevity of products; please note that the protective cover is made of a water vapor repellent fabric, perfect to prevent and protect from the formation of mold, easily washable with water and soap. Do not keep the fabric folded for a long time when it is wet. For further information about the dedicated maintenance, please refer to the technical sheet available in the "Materials" section on our website. Lastly, we recommend placing the product on terraces or verandas to guarantee its durability over the years.

For the marble top version please specify the required finish in the order.

For marble finishing with opaque polyester finish, the "Marble" Maintenance Kit is included with the product.
